CyberSecura has been registered as a "field service provider" in cybersecurity under the Plan France Relance.

Within the framework of the Plan France Relance, set up by the French government in 2020, CyberSecura has been registered as a "field service provider", and will be able to assist VSEs, SMEs and local authorities which will be able to benefit from public funding, in securing their digital transformation.

GRENOBLE, Novembre 1st, 2021 - The Plan France Relance is a programme put in place by the French government for the years 2020 to 2022 to revive the economy following the economic crisis linked to the Covid-19 pandemic.

This recovery plan has three specific components: ecology and energy transition, territorial cohesion, and business competitiveness, of which one of the key measures concerns "aid for the digital transformation of VSEs/SMEs". A budget of 34 billion euros has been allocated to this last component concerning the competitiveness of companies.

Support for the digital transformation of VSEs/SMEs

In this context of economic crisis linked to Covid-19, the number of cyber attacks has increased dangerously. Economic aid has therefore been allocated to organisations, local authorities and administrations serving the public, in order to support them in the secure digitalisation of their activities. This "cybersecurity" component of the Plan France Relance, steered by the ANSSI (National Agency for Information Systems Security), includes two security offers. The first concerns "cybersecurity": this offer is aimed at local authorities and organisations wishing to establish an inventory of their security, and to determine priority security actions. This offer, which is 100% subsidised by the Plan France Relance, is aimed at local authorities and public bodies with at least one IT department. The second offer concerns "calls for projects": this offer is intended for ministries and certain local authorities wishing to benefit from financial aid to support the securing of their digital transformation, which is likely to create new vulnerabilities. The latter is subsidised at 70%, up to a limit of €100,000.
